

Condition Of INDIA ?

According to a study by the medical journal 'Lancet', India ranks 145th out of 195 countries in the world in terms of the quality of health services and their accessibility to the people. The post is also behind Bangladesh and Bhutan in terms of quality of health services. The Global Burden of Diseases Study states that it is still a challenge in India to ensure access to health services to every Indian as compared to the year 1990. The ranking of the availability and guality of health services in India in the 2016 study was 41.2, which is much better than in 1990 (24.7). Highlights of the report with reference to India



According to Lancet

India's health care and quality ranking saw rapid improvement from the year 2000 to 2016.

A huge difference was seen between India's highest and lowest scores during this period. In the year 1990 this difference was 23.4 while in 2016 this difference increased to 30.8

According to the report, Goa and Kerala had thehighest (more than 60) marks in 2016 while Assam and Uttar Pradesh had the lowest (less than 40) marks.

The position of India is not good even compared to the neighboring countries of India. This includes China (48), Sri Lanka (71), Bangladesh (133) and Bhutan (134).

Migration




Migration has emerged asthe problem biggest in Uttarakhand. If you look at the of the Migration report Commission, till now 1702 villages have become deserted due to migration. In more than 500 villages, the population is less than 50 percent. With this, process of migration the continues unabated.



UttarakhandKranti Dal (UKD) Diwakar Bhatt told Down To Earth that the delimitation on the basis of population will definitely reduce the assembly seats and the remaining villages will cease to exist in the coming times. He says that due to the delimitation on the basis of population, the historical importance of the movement for a separate state will be lost. Environmentalist Anil Joshi also believes that there should be delimitation on geographical basis. He says that in the last delimitation the seats in rural areas had decreased while the seats in urban areas Dehradun had increased.

It has been said in the report that after the formation of a separate state, about 60 percent of the population or 32 lakh people have left their homes from Uttarakhand. The Migration Commission report says that 1,700 villages in Uttarakhand have been haunted in 2018 and there are about 1,000 villages where less than 100 people are left. Altogether 3900 villages have migrated. The population in Uttarakhand has grown at the rate of 19.17 percent between 2001 and 2011. The population of Pauri was 3,66,017 in 2001, which decreased to 3,60,442 in 2011. That is, the population of Pauri decreased by 5,575 in 10 years. The population of Almora also decreased by 5,294 during this period. 35 percent of the population living in the rural mountainous regions of the Himalayan state of Uttarakhand have left their ancestral home since the formation of the state of Uttarakhand in the year 2000. On an average 246 people are migrating from these areas every day. If the migration continues at this pace, the political geography of Uttarakhand may change.

India is an agricultural country. Agriculture is the backbone of the Indian economy. Agriculture in India has been done since the time of Indus Valley Civilization. After 1960, a new era came with the Green Revolution in the field of agriculture in the country. Some important facts related to agriculture in India are as follows:



(1) Agriculture on about 51 percent of the total area of India, grassland on 4 percent, forest on about 21 percent and 24 percent barren and unusable.

(2) About 52 percent of the total labor force of the country earns its livelihood from agriculture and related industries and businesses.

(3) The proportion of agriculture and allied goods in India's exports in 2004-2005 was about 40 percent.

(4) India ranks second after China in the production of rice in the world. Rice is cultivated on about 47 percent of the total area under food grains in India.

(5) India ranks second after China in the production of wheat in the world. Wheat is cultivated on about 15 percent of the total cultivable land of the country.

(6) Uttar Pradesh ranks first in the production of wheat in the country, while Punjab ranks first in production per hectare.

(7) The Green Revolution has had the biggest impact on the cultivation of wheat and rice, but the production of wheat increased more than rice.

(8) The credit of bringing Green Revolution in India goes to Dr. MS Swaminathan. Green Revolution started in India in 1967-1968.

(9) The First Green Revolution was followed by the Second Green Revolution in 1983–1984, in which increased grain production, investment and services to farmers expanded.

(10) Oilseeds Technology Mission was established in 1986.

(11) India is the third largest producer and consumer of fertilizers in the world.

(12) Potassium fertilizer is completely imported.

(13) India ranks first in the production of mango, banana, chikoo, sour lemon, cashew, coconut, black pepper, turmeric.(14) India ranks second in the world in the production of fruits and vegetables. And the government is busy ruining the farmers.


